Mission: April to December 2017

In link with the Coordinator of the Ocean and Climate Platform, you will identify, structure and promote ocean and climate initiatives, and you will set up a project laboratory.

You will work in direct collaboration with the college teams of the Ocean and Climate Initiatives Alliance (OCIA), with the working groups and the Scientific Committee of the Ocean and Climate Platform and the Stearing Committee of the Ocean and Climate Platform.

Your missions are the following:

Accompany the initiatives proposed to the OCIA

- identify the initiatives and pilot projects
- identify the structures to be associated
- accompany the mobilization of actors concerning the initiatives

Structure the initiatives animated and promoted by the OCIA

- elaborate a methodology to structure the ocean and climate initiatives as to help projects emerge within a project laboratory
- facilitate the creation of this project laboratory
- suggest the construction of original initiatives

Structure and draft the annual report in intelligence with the Stearing Committee of the Ocean and Climate Platform, OCIA colleagues and the general coordination.

Provide written material for the website

With a 4th or 5th year university level or Masters Degree education, you have at least 10 years experience in a position that enabled you to acquire an excellent understanding of marine issues and manage projects in their entirety, from conception to promotion. Ideally, part of your experience comes from working in the field.

Thanks to your different experiences, you have developed an ability to federate. The international environment of this position requires fluent English.
